PTA Executive members visited our Chairman Padmabhooshan Dr. P K Warriar and discussed about the measures to be adopted for the progress of the school for the year 2018-19.

Inauguration of club activities was conducted at the end of June. We have already seven clubs including value club. Varieties of activities were conducted under each club. Literary Day was celebrated under the literary club with variety of programmes highlighting the importance of all the languages, Malayalam, English, Hindi and Sanskrit. We also had programmes in connection with the value club.

A leadership programme for the students was organized under Malapuram Central Sahodaya and we also gave a motivation class for the students of Our IX and Xth grades.

We also had medical checkup in our school under DR. Binod and CH Eye Clinic conducted a vision testing for our students.
